

AREA INSIGHTS

Goldfield

Founded in 1902, Goldfield, Nevada boasted a population of 30,000 during the "boom" years of 1903 through 1907. At that time the mines produced over \$11 million in gold. Today, it is the County Seat of Esmeralda and is a mere ghost of its former self. Virgil Earp was hired as a deputy sheriff of Esmeralda County in 1905 and later died in Goldfield. Goldfield is listed in the National Registry of Historic Places in the country.

Dyer

Dyer is a community of approximately 300 residents where agriculture is the primary income. There is BLM 'open range' land in the area where cattle are allowed to roam and feed on the natural grasses. The area has geothermal springs, mountains, and lots of wildlife. It is a haven for the outdoorsman who loves fishing, camping, and hiking. Dyer is only about an hour from the ancient Bristlecone Pine forest, which has trees over 4,000 years old. It is located at the base of the White Mountain range with Boundary Peak, Nevada's highest point at 13,140 feet, just to the west.

Silver Peak

Established in 1863 as a mining camp, Silver Peak currently has a population of about 100 people. The prominent industry in the community is gold and lithium mining. It is home to the only lithium producing mine in the United States. Silver Peak is also known for a 375-foot high cinder cone (an extinct volcano) located in the Clayton Valley. Within the Silver Peak Range also is the Silver Peak caldera. Any volcanologist would appreciate this area rich in volcanic history.

MISSION STATEMENT



THE POSITION
